NSRA Shooting Council report 30th January 2021

I am sure you will all join me in wishing Iain Root well on his long road to recovery, having contracted Covid-19 during November he was admitted to hospital in December and has only recently been released from hospital into home care.

Mike Arnstein was voted in as Vice Chairman at today's meeting.

With 43 participants attending the meeting via Zoom there were lengthy discussions about the proposals and recommendations for amendments to rules relating to electronic target systems, that are due to be discussed further and voted on at the March Shooting Council meeting.

Benchrest rules are also being reviewed ahead of the March shooting Council meeting where any amendments to the rules will be discussed and voted upon.

NSRA winter league competitions have been reduced from 10 to 5 rounds and the shoot by date has been extended until the end of May. Announcements about other winter competitions will be made soon by the NSRA.

The uncertainty revolving around the on going Covid-19 restrictions has meant that the viability of running many of the summer competitions such as the Scottish and Bisley meetings remain under regular review. To have to cancel these meetings at the last minute or to run them with a very limited number of entries would result in large financial losses to the association.

The next Shooting Council meeting is due to be held on the 27th March 2021 via Zoom.
