NSRA Shooting Council report 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021

The AGM has been delayed again from its normal time at the end of July and a date for the meeting has not been set.

The NSRA are giving extensions to shoot by dates for many of the summer league competitions because many competitors are still having problems shooting their cards on time.

The new National Long Range Competition has received some 180 entries so far, which is encouraging.

Preparations for the Bisley 100 competition in 2022 are underway. The NSRA are intending to send out a survey about next years Scottish meeting to try to gauge the amount of interest in entering, as it is felt that a significant number of competitors may be drawn to the Bisley meeting. Also the venue for the 2022 Scottish meeting is in doubt because apparently there are some possible problems with running a meeting on the current site at Lauder.

The association is considering the introduction of a new Inter County 50m summer league competition, if there is sufficient interest.

It was reported that a lot of work has been done recently up grading the ranges at Aldersley and the NSRA will also have a new shop on site.

The next Shooting Council meeting is due to be held on the 27<sup>th</sup> of November 2021.
