NSRA Shooting Council report 26th of March 2022

Some updates to rule 8.15 were discussed and voted on during the meeting and take effect in April.

The selection process for the Pershing team for the match in America was discussed again and the Rifle Committee will be reviewing it for the future at their next meeting.

The potential ban on Lead in ammunition remains a very serious threat and the NSRA have information on their website and have emailed members on the subject.

Charlie Blow has stood down from his position on the Board of Management and the position is currently vacant.

Many police force areas are struggling to keep up with the demand for FAC applications, renewals and variations. FAC holders are reminded to get their renewal applications in 12 weeks or more before their certificate expires. Applications received less than 8 weeks before expiry are unlikely to get an extension period, leaving the certificate holder with an invalid certificate and all the ensuing problems.

Many club Home Office Approval Certificates expire during this year so club Secretaries are reminded to check their certificates and if necessary make their renewal applications in good time.

Should any one be going to Bisley early for the Bisley 100 meeting the NSRA are looking for volunteers to help set up the range from the 8th of August and for help at the end of the meeting to dismantle the range, if you are able to help please contact Phil Pride or Dave Froggett.
