Ensure you have 8 clips to attach your targets to the frames (Not 10m Air Pistol).

In the event of a draw, placing will be decided on count back, so ensure cards are shot in the numbered order. Closing Date for entries is the 29th August, late entries may be accepted to a minimum of 24 before shooting, but choice may be limited.

Rules on data protection mean we will no longer be using your real name in the competition (squadding notice, target labels, results etc)

You may choose a "Shooting Name" (alias, nickname or your real name) OR we will use your two initials if you leave the "Shooting Name" box on the entry form blank.

Your real name will only be used for personal communication.

Meeting Rules and Information

On arrival please report to the stats office and sign in so we know you are on site, this is an insurance requirement for both **competitors** and **visitors**. You will be issued with a badge **with your Shooting Name** on it. If you do not provide a "shooting name" we will use your two initials.

Meeting rules are displayed in the stats office, the event will be shot under ISSF/NSRA rules where appropriate.

Please put your County on the entry form as there are a number of (free) competitions for some Events. All information asked for on the entry form is required for a reason. Please contact the Organiser if you have any concerns rather than not give the information.

Classes will be allocated according to entry, with medals for each class to 3rd place if sufficient entry, however entrants performing substantially in excess of their submitted average may be reclassified.

Cards will be scored in the numbered order, please ensure you shoot them in the correct order.

Smoking or vaping is not allowed within 5m of the firing line or indoors..

We recommended that effective ear defenders are used on the Ranges when firing is in progress.

Pairs and teams must be entered in writing a minimum of one hour before shooting commences.

Juniors must be under 18 on the day of shooting.

Any sights may be used on all LSR/GRSB events and for Event 8 Muzzle loading Pistol, but no slings or specialist clothing may be worn.

Magazines must remain empty until the instruction "You may load" is given.

All weapons must comply with current NSRA rules where applicable. Please ensure you have a breech flag.

All .22 rimfire ammunition must be subsonic i.e. under 1100 fps

Centrefire Events, for pistol calibres we allow NO Magnum loads. Calibres larger than .38 accepted only if low powered (under 900fps) loads are used. All ammunition must be lead only.

Muzzle Loading Pistol, Event 60, Safety or prescription glasses **must** be worn. Two hands may be used when firing.

Except for the 10m Range, targets will be ready on the range with stickers attached. Alterations **MUST** be countersigned by the Range Officer.

The Range Officer may pause or postpone an event if the weather conditions make it unsafe to continue.

ENTRY

Rules on data protection mean we will no longer be using your real name in the competition.

You may choose a "Shooting Name" (alias, nickname or your real name) OR we will use your two initials if you leave the "Shooting Name" box on the entry form blank.

Your real name will only be used for personal communication.

1. To Enter please fill out and return the Entry Form with your remittance, see 6 below
2. Enter your average for each event, please use a fair average or I may alter the class you are allocated.
3. Choose your first, second and third choices of squads you would like to shoot in, with two squads for those events that require them. If you enter early you are more likely to get first choice.
4. Your entry will be deemed acceptance of the Match Rules.
5. You may enter by email dcsratreasurer@gmail.com with a scan or photo of the entry form, or by a phone call if you have all the information to hand and I am available
6. Payment by Cheque with Entry form, please make payable to "DCSRA". Payment may also be made by BACS, using "DC9" with your shooting or surname as a reference, your account name is automatically attached to the payment so if you use your own bank account to pay you do not need to reference your name. 8. Squadding notices will be sent by email IF I CAN READ IT, otherwise please send an SAE.

Centenary Year Additional Competitions

Combined English Match and Scottish Match, prone rifle.

Some prone rifle competitors have expressed a wish to shoot a form of English Match (60 shots at 50 yards) and a Scottish Match (60 shots at 100 yds).

As a stand alone competition within the one weekend format this would be very disruptive, but there is a way to achieve something similar.

If competitors enter Event 20 Double Dewar (two squads) and Event 24 Single Dewar (two squads) and write "Combined" on the entry form we will produce scores for the combined English Match and the Combined Scottish Match. There is no extra charge.

For information a Single Dewar is 20 shots at 50 yds (one card) & 20 shots at 100 yds (one card) and a Double Dewar is 40 shots at 50 yds (two cards) and 40 shots at 100 yds (two cards)

The English Match (Event 26) on the South range will be unaffected as that still will be for those who wish to only shoot 60 shots at 50 yds The South Range is wheelchair accessible.

ASTOR CUP ARRANGEMENTS 9th June 2024

Astor Cup competitors will have priority on Squad K* at 11.20 and Squad L* at 13.20.

There will be no shooting on any adjacent ranges so there is no need for special arrangements. However the Events will start promptly.

Astor Cup Rules, Devon County. June 2024

1. The competition is run to select the Club to represent Devon at the finals usually held at Bisley. The County will pay the Bisley entry fee, but all other costs are funded by the club or its competitors.
2. The competition is a single Dewar event run concurrently with the Prone Rifle Dewar Event 24 at the Devon and Open Meeting in June.
Entry information for Event 24, Single Dewar and 25, Astor Cup is detailed on the meeting "Squads and Information" sheet.
3. Each team of six will shoot together at the same time at each distance. For the June 2024 Competition this will be during Squad K* and Squad L*.
- 4.. The intention to enter a team must be notified to the organisers of the June meeting by the closing date for entries for that meeting, June 5th June 2023 as shown on the Entry Form.
Space will then be reserved on Squads K* & L*.
If only one club or less has entered the competition will not take place.
5. The team, chosen from the competitors of the Single Dewar event, Event 24 or entered solely for the Astor Cup competition Event 25, must be received in writing by the Organisers a minimum of one hour before the start of the first detail so for the 2024 meeting, by 10.20am on the 9th of June.
Do not assume that email or text messages sent on the day will be received in time.
6. Club Captains are advised to inform likely team members so they may select the correct squads if they are entering the Double Dewar, Event 20 or the Single Dewar Events 24 or 25.
7. For those shooting Event 20 Double Dewar the first numbered card at each distance will count towards the team score.
8. There is a team entry fee of £12.00 and just the normal competition and range fee of each competitor in the DCSRA June Meeting, or if only shooting the Astor Cup Event 25, the Range Fee.
Juniors, under 18 on the day of the competition, have totally free entry.
